Old Town Cape's Downtown Christmas Open House Coming Soon

Cape Girardeau – Old Town Cape is hosting its annual Downtown Christmas Open House on Friday, December 3 from 5 to 9 pm.

Attractions include great holiday shopping and special in store events, free carriage rides, free pictures with Santa, children's activities in Santa's Workshop, caroling and a \$1500 DOWNTOWN SHOPPING SPREE PACKAGE.

To compete for the \$1500 downtown shopping spree shoppers must visit a registration booth to fill out an entry form and receive their ticket packet. This will register the shoppers' entry number, but does not enter them into the drawing.
