CAPE GIRARDEAU, MO. – Old Town Cape is hosting its annual Downtown Christmas Open House on Friday, December 7 from 5 to 9 p.m.

Attractions include great holiday shopping and special in-store events, caroling, free wagon rides, free pictures with Santa and children's activities in Santa's Workshop (116 N. Main) and the chance to win a \$1500 downtown shopping spree.
