CAPE GIRARDEAU, MO. – The fall season of Old Town Cape's Tunes at Twilight starts Friday, August 16 at 6:30 p.m. with Jack Williams.

Southeast Health, premier sponsor of the event, will host a give away during the concert to kick off the season. Free raffle tickets will be distributed to those attending the concert and a drawing will be held at the end of the concert for a gift basket filled with Southeast Health swag.

Williams is counted among the most dynamic performers on today's "folk" circuit. His 54-year career of playing folk, rock, jazz, R&B, classical and the popular music of the 30s, 40s and 50s has lead him to where he is today. He is a storyteller in an old Southern tradition who further illustrates each tale with his guitar. Future fall performers include Anne McCue, The Melroys, Warren Wilken, Jimmy Davis and John Latini.

Tunes at Twilight is an award winning outdoor concert series held on Friday nights at the Common Pleas Courthouse Gazebo (Lorimier and Broadway) in downtown Cape Girardeau. Families from all parts of Cape and surrounding communities come downtown every week for the free, hour long concert for 6 weeks in the spring and 6 weeks in the fall. While Old Town Cape and key volunteers plan and organize the event every year, Tunes at Twilight is sponsored by Southeast Health, Cape Air and FOX 23 KBSI and grant assistance is provided through the Missouri Arts Council.
