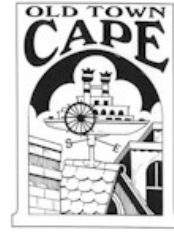

OLD TOWN CAPE KICKS OFF TUNES AT TWILIGHT FALL SERIES

Cape Girardeau, MO – The fall series of Old Town Cape's Tunes at Twilight starts this Friday, August 12 at 6:30 p.m. with singer-songwriter Daniel Whittington.

Daniel Whittington has been performing in venues of all shapes and sizes since the age of 11. He spent the first of his music career playing bars and clubs all over central Texas with his dad's blues band. In 1999, he joined a band and began touring. They released 4 extended play discs and 1 full length album. In 2008 Daniel began work on a solo album and performing acoustic shows in Hollywood, CA. After 3 months of working on the album, he moved to Austin to continue pursuing a solo career and to complete the album in Texas.

Tunes at Twilight is an award winning outdoor concert series held on Friday nights at the Common Pleas Courthouse Gazebo (Lorimier and Broadway) in Cape Girardeau. The series provides a free hour long concert for 6 weeks in the spring and 6 weeks in the fall. The Premier event sponsor is SoutheastHEALTH. Additional sponsors include Cape Air and Montgomery Bank and grant assistance is provided through the Missouri Arts Council.
