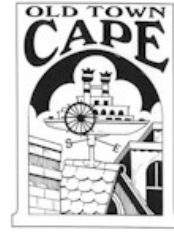

OLD TOWN CAPE KICKS OFF TUNES AT TWILIGHT SPRING SERIES

Cape Girardeau, MO – The spring series of Tunes at Twilight, organized by Old Town Cape and sponsored by The Bank of Missouri, Southeast Missouri Hospital and the Missouri Arts Council starts this Friday, May 14 at 7 p.m. with singer-songwriter Doug MacLeod.
